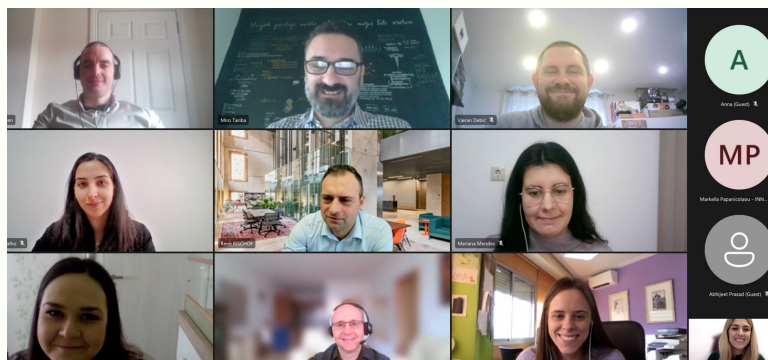


Skill-Pics MOOC
